Regarded internationally as an authority on structural use of glass, James was the recipient of the 2010 the Queen's Award for Enterprise in the category of Innovation and many other awards including the 2014 IStructE Supreme Award for Excellence, the 2016 Milne Medal, the glass industry's 2017 Phoenix Award. He holds the position on the Sounding Board at the Design Council – the UK Government's adviser on Design.
